### **PERCENTAGE RATE TENDER & CONTRACT FOR WORKS**

#### **General rules and Directions for the Guidance of Contractors**

1. All works proposed for execution by contract will be notified in a form of invitation to tender posted in public place signed by the Asst. General Manager (CE), Food Corporation of India, Regional Office, Bangalore - 560 041.

This form will state the work to be carried out as well as the date for submitting and opening tenders and the time allowed for carrying out the work; also the amount of earnest money to be deposited with the tender, and the amount of the security deposit to be deposited by the successful tenderer and the percentage at which the security deposit shall be deducted from the bills of the successful tenderer. Copies of the specifications, designs, drawing and schedule of quantities and the works signed for the purpose of identification by the Asst. General Manager (CE) Food Corporation of India, Regional Office, Bangalore - 560 041, shall also be open for inspection by the contractor and the office of the Asst. General Manager (Civil/Elec.), Food Corporation of India, Regional Office, Bangalore - 560 041, during office hours.

2. In event of the tenderer being submitted by a firm, it must be signed separately by each partner thereof, or in the event of the absence of any partner, it must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorising him to do so, such power of attorney to be produced with the tender, and It must disclose that the firm is duly registered under the Indian Partnership Act.

Wherever Contractor furnishes power of Attorney the same should be registered and accompanied with an Affidavit from Contractor.

3. Receipts for payments made on account of work when executed by a firm, must also be signed by the several partners, except where the contractors are described in their tender as a firm, in which case the receipts must be signed in the name of the firm by one of the partners, or by some other person having authority to give effectual receipts for the firm.
4. Any person who submits a tender shall fill up the usual printed form, stating at how much percent above or below the estimated rates specified in Rule, 1, he is willing to undertake the work. Only one rate of percentage more or less over the estimated rates/schedule's rates shall be named Tenderer which propose any alteration in the work specified in the said form of invitation to tender or in the time allowed for carrying out the work, or which contain any other condition of the sort, will be liable to rejection. No single tender shall include more than one work, but contractors who wish to tender for two or more works shall submit a separate tender for each. Tenders shall have the name and number of the work to which they refer, written outside the envelopes.

5. The Asst. General Manager (CE), Food Corporation of India, Regional Office, Bangalore - 41 of his duly authorised assistant will open tenders in the presence of any intending contractors who may be present at the time and will enter the amount of several tenders in a Comparative Statement in suitable form. In the event of a tender being accepted, a receipt for the earnest money forwarded therewith shall be given to the contractor who shall there upon for the purpose of identification sign copies of the specifications and other documents mentioned in Rule 1. In the event of a tender being rejected, the earnest money forwarded with such an accepted tender shall thereupon be returned to the contractor.
6. The Food Corporation of India, shall have the right of rejecting all or any of the tenders, and will not be bound to accept the lowest tender.
7. The receipt of an accountant or clerk for any money paid by the contractor will not be considered as any acknowledgment of payment to the Asst. General Manager (CE), Food Corporation of India, Regional Office, Bangalore - 560 041 and the contractor shall be responsible for seeing that he procures a receipt signed by the Asst. Manager (A/cs), Food Corporation of India, Regional Office, Bangalore - 560 041 or duly authorised cashier.
8. The memorandum of work tendered for, and the schedule of materials to be supplied by the Corporation and their issue rates shall be filled in and completed in the office of the Asst. General Manager (CE), Food Corporation of India, Regional Office, Bangalore - 560 041 before the tender form is issued, if a form is issued, to an intending tenderer without having been so filled in and completed he shall request the office to have this done before he completes and delivers his tender.
